HE IS COMING, SOON

Jesus Christ, the creator of the heavens and earth is coming soon. Are you prepared to meet your creator just as you are? Jesus Christ the righteous Judge of the living and the dead is coming soon. Are you ready for the judgement day? (2 Tim 4:1)

Although, the day and the hour of His return is not known (Mat 24:36), His Word assured that He is coming soon to give to everyone according to his/her work (Rev 22:12).

Jesus has promised to reward the righteous in Him with eternal life, honour and glory but He will punish the unrighteous and evil doers with God's wrath, indignation, affliction, distress, separation from His presence and everlasting destruction. (Rom 2:7,8, 2 Thess. 1:9).

All humans are sinners (Rom 3:23); Your good deeds are not good enough to save you, your self-righteous deeds or actions will not suffice on the day of Judgement. Some people believe there are other ways humans can be freed from sin and its deadly consequences but only the blood of Jesus atones for our sins and iniquities.

The just or righteous shall live by faith (Hab. 2:4). The righteous Judge will only accept the righteousness of God.

God's righteousness is freely given, you can neither earn it through works nor purchase it by any means. One's acceptance of God's free gift results in one's justification and reconciliation to Himself (Rom 1:17).

God made His only begotten Son, Jesus Christ who knew no sin, to be sin on our behalf, so that in His Son, Jesus Christ, we might become the righteousness of God (2 Cor 5:21).

God's righteousness is received only through faith in His Son, Jesus Christ. You can receive God's righteousness by believing and trusting in Jesus Christ, relying on His grace and being obedient to His will (John 3:16, 15:10).

The sins of some are obvious, reaching the place of judgment ahead of them; the sins of others trail behind them (1 Tim 5:24).
