

## **Are you aware of this historical fact backed with evidence?**

The Saviour Jesus Christ, called the Son of God, was crucified and pronounced dead. He was buried and rose from the dead on the third day (1 Cor. 15:3-5).

People went to the tomb of Jesus' burial but could not find His body (Matthew 28:1; Luke 8:3). The same people met angels who bore witness and testified that Jesus Christ was not among the dead, He had risen (Luke 24:5,6). Others went to the tomb of burial to ascertain the information and returned to verify that the information was accurate (Luke 24:12).

The resurrected Jesus appeared to two men on their journey from Jerusalem to Emmaus. He appeared to 11 men and showed them his pierced hands and feet. After that, He appeared to more than five hundred men and women at the same time. These all then affirmed and confessed that 'He is Risen' and shared this

good news of Jesus Christ's resurrection from the dead.

Those who meet with Jesus Christ are filled with joy and gladness and continue to share the good news of His resurrection.

## **Are you aware that the punishment for sin is death? (Rom 6:23).**

The Redeemer Jesus Christ, though blameless, took upon Himself the punishment for sin, which is death, so He could pay our debts and forgive us our sin if we are willing to believe in Him and follow Him.

## **Are you aware that Christ died for you and has risen for you personally?**

If you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. For with the heart one believes and is justified, and with the mouth one confesses and is saved. (Rom 10:9,10).
