Acknowledge that you lack true freedom and have no hope if you are without fellowship with God in this world (Eph. 2:12).

The Ethiopian official invited, accepted and confessed Jesus by faith to receive the one thing needful, he went away rejoicing (Acts 8:35-39).

Invite and accept Jesus to receive the One Thing Needful - the forgiveness of your sins, salvation of your soul and eternal life (Jer. 29:13).

One Thing Needful



ou must be born again is Jesus Christ's statement of fact that this one thing is needful for all humanity (John 3:7).

The Ethiopian eunuch was a man who possessed all the world could offer but lacked the one needful thing (Act 8) Nicodemus had position and religion but lacked the one needful thing (John 3).

Power: Power, authority and charisma can grant one rights to the total control and governance of a whole nation, its treasury, fiscal policies and economic destiny but power will not give or grant access to the one needful thing - **Salvation of the Soul**.

Wealth: Wealth, riches and financial means may assist to procure privileges, excursions and pilgrimages to any religious site. Money can be used to purchase copies of religious books and religious rituals but cannot buy the one thing that is needful-Freedom from Sin. Do not assume that gain is godliness.

Education: Through education, humanity may learn

different skills and acquire countless abilities. Through literacy and numeracy humanity can read, write, understand, analyse, reason, interpret data and communicate in other languages. However, **Eternal Life**, the one needful thing, is not acquired through learning or by human skill, ability, knowledge, wisdom and understanding.

Religion / Non-Religion: Humanity will not find the one needful thing through their commitment or devotion to vain religious beliefs and observances. The one thing needful will not be found through hostility or indifference to religion.

Indulgence: Beside religion, humanity will always turn to other things to do or have for pleasure because of their desire to find true happiness. However, they will neither find satisfaction nor fulfilment but bondage because such pleasures are devoid of the one needful thing (2 Pet. 2:19).

The thing which is highly esteemed among men is abomination in the sight of God.
